

Well Water You Can Trust



Moving into a home with a private well can be intimidating, but with knowledge you can relax and be confident in your new home purchase.

The standard potability testing provided by the Ontario Government is important to determine if your well contains certain bacteria and should be conducted regularly. However, a negative result is not necessarily an indication of quality drinking water. Contaminants such as nitrates, nitrites, sodium, lead, and ammonia, to name a few, along with other types of bacteria can be present but not detectable by sight, smell, or taste.

If these and other organic and inorganic materials are present you are not restricted to drinking bottled water. Proper treatment will provide safe, superior drinking water without the expense and inconvenience of bottles. Plus, you are in control of your drinking water quality.

The Ontario Ministry of the Environment recently made public warnings regarding a company offering door-to-door water testing indicating alarming, although false, results to sell their expensive treatment equipment. Giving in to these tactics can cost you thousands of dollars simply to meet someone's sales quotas.

While free, on-site tests offered by water treatment companies can provide basic information, it's not always sufficient to effectively recommend the required treatment. If their equipment fails to properly treat your water, changing water tables are often blamed. Other equipment is then suggested leading to additional expense.

Before purchasing treatment systems, a comprehensive lab analysis will provide the necessary information to determine if any treatment is required or if a certified well technician should be consulted. Changes to your well water can occur, but are normally due to surface water infiltration or drilling adjacent to your property. Possible causes of well contamination include a deteriorating casing, old seals or backflow due to high runoff (in a shallow well).

Take the time to learn about your well water, and don't give in to the propaganda that quality drinking water only comes from a bottle. Clean, clear, fresh-tasting water can come from your very own well!
